Nuts

We're a nut free school due to children with allergies. Please can parents remember not to send nuts in any form into school in packed lunches or as snacks. This includes foods such as Nutella or chocolate spread. There can also be sensitivity to items containing nuts including hand creams or lip balms. **These items should not be in school unless prescribed.**



Additional support in school

Following Covid, schools have additional funding to support children's missed learning. We use this to support interventions in school and purchase resources. This term we are also able to run tutoring sessions with Armin, the York City coach and Mariam, from M2R, who tutors children virtually.
