### Covid

Following the removal of legal restrictions on 24<sup>th</sup> February we are pleased to be transitioning back to our new normal. We will continue to keep some measures in place which will support everyone in this transitional time;

- Regular handwashing
- Separate toilets for each class
- **Ventilation of all school buildings alongside monitoring CO2 levels in classrooms;** it can be cold, please can children wear vests or a base layer under their uniform if they are cold.

At playtimes all children will be able to mix in all areas of the playground. At lunchtime we will continue to have Reception, Year 1, 2 and 3 eating first followed by Year 4, 5 and 6. Parents and visitors to site are not expected to wear facemasks but we understand that some people may prefer to continue wearing them.

We will be following the **NHS** guidance regarding isolating;

While you're no longer required by law to self-isolate if you have COVID-19, you should still stay at home and avoid contact with other people. This helps reduce the chance of passing COVID-19 on to others.

### When to stay at home

You should stay at home and avoid contact with other people if you:

- have any of the main symptoms of COVID-19
- have tested positive for COVID-19 this means you have the virus

The guidance is expected to be updated on 1st April.


