#### School Lunch costs 2022-23

Our lunches are provided through NYES Catering (North Yorkshire) who set the price annually. As everyone is acutely aware, prices of food and fuel have risen significantly. The cost of school lunches for children in Year 3 to Year 6 will be £3.16 per day from September. The menu is available online and will be updated termly.

If you think that you might be eligible for free school meals please <u>complete an online application</u>. We would ask families in Reception, Year 1 and 2 to consider whether they are eligible at the moment for two reasons; firstly, once awarded the child remains eligible until the end of primary school even if circumstances change. Secondly, our school receives additional funding for children receiving free meals.
